Welcome to the 2026 Noosa District Netball Club Carnival

Please ensure all your team take the time to read over the following information to ensure a smooth running of the carnival and an enjoyable day for everyone.

GAME INFORMATION

DATE	Sunday, 9 th August 2026
START TIME	8.00am approx.
DRAW	The draw will be available via Netball Connect no later than 1 week prior to the Carnival.
GAMES	2 x 10 minute halves, 2 minute break at half time There will be 3 minutes between each round
UMPIRING	Each team MUST supply a suitable umpire for their own team for the day
CHECK IN	All Teams must check in at the Games Admin office at the beginning of the carnival in case there are any changes. <i>Only one person per team needs to do this.</i>
UNIFORMS	All players must be in full team uniform for the entire carnival including correct positional bibs
SCORING	Scoring will be via Netball connect live scoring. Each team must have a registered manager/scorer to access live scoring on the day. This person can assign scoring duties to other netball connect users via the app if required. Each team MUST supply a scorer at each game, and they MUST stand together and agree on the score. The Team listed on the left hand side of the draw is responsible for providing the device to score. Any disputes require both scorers to present to the Games Admin office Each team must nominate a Team Manager that will be assigned scorer duties. The Manager will then be able to assign different scorers during the carnival if they wish. **Paper score sheets will be available if required**
NETBALL QLD	ALL Players MUST be registered with Netball Queensland before taking to the court.
INJURY TIME	No injury time will be added to playing time



GAME INFORMATION cont...

ROLLING SUBS	Rolling subs are permitted, but must take place from the designated rolling subs box
INTERCHANGE PLAYERS	Players are not permitted to play between teams or divisions. Each player must remain in one team only for the duration of the carnival.
WEATHER	In August, Noosa is typically warm and sunny. However, if wet weather occurs, updates will be shared via our Facebook and Instagram pages.
POINTS	Points will be awarded as follows: WIN = 2 points DRAW = 1 point LOSS = 0 POINTS WINE ON FORFEIT = 2 POINTS
PRESENTATIONS	Medals will be awarded to the winners and runners up in each divisions (9 per team). Medals will be presented after the last game for each division

FIRST AID	A first aid representative will be on site. If an ambulance is required, the first aid representative or Noosa Netball will call for one
WATER	There is a water tap available to refill bottles or containers located at the Club house near court 9
TEAM/SUPPORTER TENTS	Teams and supporters can set up their own marquees on the day. Please refer to the map for the allocated areas Tents MUST be securely pegged into the ground <i>ACCESS for marquee setup is from 6am on Sunday 9th April</i>
FOOD	A variety of food and beverage vendors will be on site including <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Coffee van - Lions Club BBQ - Netball Canteen - Wood fire Pizza - Additional Food vendors to be confirmed
COOKING	NO cooking by teams or spectators is allowed
ALCOHOL	NO alcohol is permitted at the Carnival
TOILETS	Toilets are located within the Clubhouse complex. Additional toilets will be located as per the map
RUBBISH	Rubbish bins will be placed around the grounds. Please keep your tent area and the netball grounds tidy
PARKING	Parking MAP will be confirmed closer to the Carnival.
PETS	NO PETS are permitted within the Noosa Netball complex during the carnival.
