GAME DAY

Scoring	All games will be live scored via Netball Connect. Paper scoresheets will only be available if there are connection issues.
Umpiring	Umpires will be allocated by the Association for the 10 week competition. All teams must nominate a capable team umpire. Team umpires will only be used if an appointed umpire is unable to fulfil their allocation.
Canteen	Canteen will be unavailable for this competition.
Grounds duty	Teams will be allocated to set-up or pack-up grounds duty during the season via a roster.
