Players must be registered before taking to the court.</p>
Season Fees	<p>\$173 NDNA Membership + \$44 QLD Membership (for players 16 & over)**</p> <p><small>** Netball QLD membership is capped annually. Depending on which, if any competitions you've previously registered to you may have already reached the cap and will not have to pay the total fee. Players aged under 16 years need to pay the applicable Junior QLD membership of \$133.</small></p>
Refunds	<p>Refund of NDNA Membership fee due to a season-ending injury or medical condition must be via written application with supporting documentation (eg. Medical Certificate) to the Noosa District Netball Association Management Committee.</p> <p>The amount refunded is at the discretion of the NDNA Management Committee. No other refunds will be considered.</p> <p>ALL REFUNDS will incur a \$25 administration fee</p>

Grading	Full game on Weeks 1 & 2 - earned ladder points are retained for the competition
Fixture games	2 x 20-minute halves
Ladder points	<p>WIN - 2 points DRAW - 1 point LOSS - 0 points FORFEITURE - FORFEITING TEAM - 0 points (Refer forfeit fines & scratch match info) FORFEITURE - NON-FORFEITING TEAM - 2 points</p>
Rolling Subs	Permitted - must be in accordance with SOPP 11.5
Borrowing Players	Permitted - must be in accordance with SOPP 11.4
Weather, environmental or venue cancellations	Fixture dates are subject to change based upon the availability of venues and travel conditions. Should the NDNA deem it unsafe for players or officials to be travelling due to adverse weather/environmental conditions, rounds may be postponed or cancelled. Postponed rounds may be replayed subject to the availability of venues.
Finals Eligibility	Play a minimum of three (3) games in your team to qualify to play in finals - SOPP 11.6
Finals	Semi Final 1st on ladder vs 4th on ladder - winner to Grand Final

Umpiring	Umpires will be allocated by the Association for the competition duration. Each team must nominate a capable 'team umpire'. Team umpires will only be used if an appointed umpire is unable to fulfil their allocation (Refer Umpiring fines)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">In the event of a forfeiture, please ensure you advise NDNA as soon as possible via call/text/voicemail on 0438 638 899 in the first instance or via email to noosanetball@gmail.com			
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Teams are encouraged to play a scratch match in the event of a forfeiture. If a scratch match is played, the forfeiting team receives no points, nor will they be credited with any goals scored. The forfeiture fine is waived in this instance.			
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The forfeiting team must have at least 3 registered players from their team available to take to the court			
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The non-forfeiting team cannot refuse to play a scratch match			
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">In the case of a team advising their intention to forfeit a match in a specific round, and the match is subsequently cancelled due to adverse weather, then the notice of intention to forfeit will no longer be valid. The affected team will be eligible to play in the rescheduled match.
