Enclosed please find the following information for the 2023 Season 1 Indoor Competition.

1. Team Nomination & Affiliation Form – to be emailed by **FRIDAY, 3RD FEBRUARY, 2023** to noosanetball@gmail.com
This is required so that your Team Name can be set up in the online system allowing your players to register to your team.
2. **Individual memberships must be paid online by WEDNESDAY, 15TH FEBRUARY, 2023.** Please ensure your players are aware of this date. The membership fee includes all player fees for Season 1.
We cannot accept your team nomination if you do not have a minimum of 7 player memberships by this date.
You will still be able to register players during the season if necessary, however for grading purposes all players commencing the season must have paid membership by 15th February 2023.
3. **You must** provide your signed Team Registration Card at the first grading game on 20th February 2023.
4. **Affiliation Fees** – affiliation fees must be paid into Noosa Netball's bank account by **Wednesday, 15th February 2023.**
Affiliation Fees: \$5.00 per team or \$ 20.00 per club (two or more teams) (COMPULSORY FEE) paid with Game Fees into NDNA Bank Account by 15th February 2023.
ALL TEAMS MUST BE AFFILIATED.
*Clubs/Teams are only required to affiliate **once** per year and when paid for 2023 this fee is not required for any other competition your team/club competes in this year.*

5. Any individual players who are wishing to nominate and do not have a team should email noosanetball@gmail.com and we will endeavor to place them into a team
6. **Attendance at Annual General Meeting:** One representative from each nominated team, or at a maximum of two representatives from a Club are required to attend the NDNA Annual General Meeting scheduled for 9am, Saturday 4 March 2023.

Umpiring

- Each team is **required to nominate a suitable umpire** for their team for the season. When required, your team will be asked to umpire at a time when your team is NOT playing.
- Failure to supply an umpire, will result in a fine. The fine is \$50/game, if a replacement is found, or \$100/game if a game is cancelled due to lack of umpires. Failure to supply an umpire will also incur a loss of 2 competition points.

Details of 2023 costs as follows:

Player Membership Fee	\$265.00 per player if this is your first season for 2023. This membership fee is inclusive of all charges for the season, excluding any fines that may become payable. \$160.00 per player for second and/or subsequent season in the 2023 calendar year (ie anyone who is registered in a Noosa or another Association's competition for 2023). NOTE: To be eligible for second/subsequent season discount you must be registered in another Netball Qld competition in that year.
Non Player Fee	\$Nil - Coaches, Umpires, Club personnel who are not registered players – you are still asked to register however there is no fee charged in 2023.
Affiliation Fee	As above (4. Affiliation Fees)

Injuries**Refunds**

Refund of membership fees due to season ending injury will be via written application with supporting documentation and at the discretion of the Management Committee. No other refunds will be considered.

Penalty Fines**Forfeit Fine**

* 1st & 2nd forfeit of the season - No penalty if **24 hours or more** notice is given and a scratch match played, otherwise \$50 fine payable before next game.

* 3rd forfeit, with or without 24 hours notice, \$100 fine.

Teams to show cause as to why they should be allowed to continue to participate in that competition.

Umpiring Fine

\$ 50.00 if NDNA can source a replacement umpire

\$ 100.00 if a replacement umpire cannot be sourced

Note that this fine is classed as a team fine if the nominated umpire is a team umpire.

- No refund of any membership fees paid will be made to either the forfeiting team or the team that receives the forfeit.
- No refund of any membership fees paid will be made to either team should a game have to be abandoned due to the no show of an umpire.
- In the case of a team who advised their intention to forfeit a game for a specific round and the game is subsequently postponed due to wet weather, then the notice of intention to forfeit will no longer be valid. Such teams will be eligible to play in the rescheduled match.
- Note that there is no change to the awarding of points to the team that has received the forfeit - the team that has forfeited receives no points nor will they be credited with any goals scored if a scratch match is played.
