Players <b>must</b> be registered before taking to the court.
Refunds	Refund of NDNA Membership fee due to a season-ending injury or medical condition must be via written application with supporting documentation (eg. Medical Certificate) to the Noosa District Netball Association Management Committee. The amount refunded is at the discretion of the NDNA Management Committee. No other refunds will be considered. <b>ALL REFUNDS will incur a \$25 administration fee</b>

Fixture games	4 x 8 minute quarters
Ladder points	WIN - 2 points DRAW - 1 point LOSS - 0 points FORFEITURE - FORFEITING TEAM - 0 points (Refer forfeit fines & scratch match info) FORFEITURE - NON-FORFEITING TEAM - 2 points
Rolling Subs	Permitted - must be in accordance with SOPP 11.5
Borrowing Players	Permitted - must be in accordance with SOPP 11.4
Weather, environmental or venue cancellations	Our standard wet-weather policy applies, however, if abnormal wet-weather conditions result in game cancellations, competitions & programs MAY be extended at the discretion of the NDNA management committee

<b>Finals</b>	No Finals - Division winner is first-past-the-post on ladder points. If the points are equal, the winner will be decided by goals for and against. Only the winning team will receive an award.			
<b>UNIFORMS</b>				
<b>Uniforms</b>	Players must be in full uniform at all times, however: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teams are permitted four (4) calendar weeks from Week 1 to be in full uniform</li><li>• Players registering during the season are permitted four (4) calendar weeks from registering to be in full uniform.</li></ul>			
<b>GAME DAY</b>				
<b>Scoring</b>	<b>Live Scoring</b> via Netball Connect app by the nominated team-scorer is preferred.  Paper scoring is available if required - please see the Games Controller for a paper score-sheet before the match starst.			
<b>Umpiring</b>	Umpires will be allocated by the Association for the competition duration.  Each team must nominate a capable 'team umpire'. Team umpires will only be used if an appointed umpire is unable to fulfil their allocation (Refer Umpiring fines)			
<b>Grounds Duty</b>	Assistance with setup and packdown of Pole protectors will be required			
<b>Fines</b>	<b>Umpiring - failure of a team to provide an umpire when requested</b> ..... Umpire failing to do a duty - NDNA <b>able</b> to source a replacement umpire\$50.00 ..... Umpire failing to do a duty - NDNA <b>unable</b> to source a replacement umpire and match abandoned\$100.00 ..... <b>Forfeiture of Match</b> ..... 1st forfeit <b>with</b> at least 24-hours notice\$- ..... 1st forfeit <b>without at least</b> 24-hours notice\$100.00 ..... 2nd forfeit <b>with/without</b> at least 24-hours notice\$150.00 ..... 3rd forfeit <b>with/without</b> at least 24-hours notice **\$150.00 ..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Team to show cause why they should be permitted to continue to participate in that competition</li></ul> ..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the event of a forfeiture, please ensure you advise NDNA as soon as possible via call/text/voicemail on 0438 638 899 <b>in the first instance</b> or via email to noosanetball@gmail.com</li></ul> ..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Teams are encouraged to play a <b>scratch match</b> in the event of a forfeiture. If a scratch match is played, the forfeiting team receives no points, nor will they be credited with any goals scored. The forfeiture fine is waived in this instance.</li></ul> ..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The forfeiting team must have at least 3 registered players from their team available to take to the court</li></ul> ..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The non-forfeiting team cannot refuse to play a scratch match</li></ul> ..... <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In the case of a team advising their intention to forfeit a match in a specific round, and the match is subsequently cancelled due to adverse weather, then the notice of intention to forfeit will no longer be valid. The affected team will be eligible to play in the rescheduled match.</li></ul>
